After a woman completes her time in jail or prison, she is released and often finds herself in a vulnerable position. She can choose to go back to her old, unhealthy environment or brave the streets alone, but very few options exist for someone who has no money, no home, and a criminal record. Your investment changes the lives of these women, their children, and our entire community.



THERAPEUTIC HOME

A positive, Christ-centered home allows a woman to learn that she is truly loved by God and her life has meaning. Assistance and accountability provide her with a stable home where she can thrive. A church family and loving mentors allow her to build strong, healthy relationships and become a better mother, sister, or friend.

TRAUMA RECOVERY & RELAPSE PREVENTION

Most of the women who make choices that lead to incarceration come from backgrounds of sexual and physical abuse, poverty, mental illness, and/or addiction. Support from trained professionals and spiritual mentors can help women find healing from the past and find hope for the future.



EDUCATION & EMPLOYMENT

Education, skill-development, and employment assistance are key components to a woman's ability to provide for herself long-term.
